1. **APOLOGIES**

A pologies for their in a bility to attend the Meeting were received from Councillors Agelink, Suttle and Trite.

2. ALCOHOLCONTROLINPUBLICPLACES

The Mayor welcomed In sp. Holland to the Meeting, and invited him to put forward the views of the police regarding the control of alcohol in public places.

In sp. Holland explained the existing powers already afforded to the police for the control of anti-social drinking in public places, and expressed the opinion that the designation of specific areas under the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 was intended as a preventative measure for "hot spots".

Specificareasthatgavecauseforconcernwereidentified,includingthe ShelteronShoreRoad,theRailwayStation,andpeopledrinkingalcoholinthe streetsoutsideofpublichouses.InspectorHollandconfirmedthatthepolicealready hadpowerstodealwithincidentsintheselocations,andalengthydiscussionensued regardingthemeritsofdesignatingspecificareasas"AlcoholFreeZones".
