# 1. **APOLOGIES**

# 2. <u>PARKINGPROPOSALSAT PEVERILPOINT</u>

#### 1. Residents

The Clerk provided Members with details of outstanding issues relating to the proposals at Peveril Point. Information was given regarding land ownership issues as identified by the Council's solicitors. No details were provided regarding the rights of way is sues related to individual properties.

The Clerk detailed the matters related to the classification of Broad Road and Peveril Point Road as a 'bridleway'. The Chairman re-affirmed the Council's intention not to restrict access over the road way and the potential use of designated areas for parking.

Following ageneral discussion regarding the need to progress matters, it was decided to set out a course of action.
