The Clerk presented a plan from the Kingston Football Club requesting permission to construct a dugout in Forres Field.

During the ensuring lengthy debate concern was expressed, regarding the proposed design, and the use of concrete blocks. The use of Forres Field as a venue for football was discussed, given that Days Park was gifted to the town for the purpose of a pleasure park and football ground. Consideration was also given to the possible siting of a dugout in King Georges Playing Field.

It was Proposed by Councillor Baume, Seconded by Councillor Farrow and AGREED that: -

The request to site a dugout on Forres Field be refused.

A letter be sent to Kingston Football Club to advise that.

An enhanced design and specification be presented for consideration by the King Georges Field Charitable Trust.
