<u>MR.M.STOLLERY</u> referredtoplanningapplicationNo.6/2003/0836(theHavenhurst Hotel,3CranborneRoad)andasked`thattheTownCouncilgiveconsiderationtoa requestforthebuildingtobe"listed".

 $\underline{ COUNCILLORC.BRIGHT } \\ referred to the sterling work under taken by the Festive \\ Lights Committee, together with traders and private householders in the town, which had resulted in such an excellent display. Approximately 300 properties had been judged, and the results of the competition would be announced shortly.$
