In the absence of a clergy man, Councillor Mrs. Marshoffered as hortprayer before the commencement of the Meeting.

Councillor Miller (Town Mayor) welcomed those present and invited questions from the audience.

MR.C.BRIGHT referredtotheproposaltoerectbeachhutsonthegrassedareainthe vicinityoftheTouristInformationCentre,andwasinformedthatitwasnotintendedto progressthematter.HethenreferredtotheCCTVsystemthathadrecentlybeen installedandenquiredhowmanycameraswerelinkedtothecontrolcentre.Hewas informedbytheTownClerkthattwofixedcamerasandoneoperatorcontrolledcamera werelinkeddirectlytothesystem.Inaddition,thepolicehada"hotspot"camera whichcouldbeusedinyariouslocations.

<u>MRS.M.DIGHT</u> expressed the opinion that these ating around the Bandstandwas not adequate to meet public demand, and enquire diffit was intended to re-instates ome of these at sthat had been removed. The Operations Manager explained that the area had suffered as pate of vandalism, and that there was no additional seating available for replacement at the present time. It was hoped that more seating would be provided in the future, if budget constraints would allow.

The Town Council's website had been very successfully enhanced, and the Purbeck District Council's website was proving popular. Access to Council Minutes and other general information was also now available through this source.
