

NOTES on the **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**
TIME held on **MONDAY, 27th MAY, 2002**
in the Town Hall, Swanage at 7 o'clock p.m.

In addition to Members of the Council and officers,
approx. 21 members of the public attended the Meeting.

Councillor Suttle (Town Mayor) welcomed those present and invited questions from the audience.

MR. GEORGE WILLEY reported on a recent visit to Rudesheim am Rhein, enjoyed by members of the Swanage Town Twinning Association. He conveyed "Best Wishes" from the Mayor of Rudesheim and presented Councillor Suttle with a book, entitled "Hochheim am Main".

MR. FOOKS referred to the removal of the waste bin at the top of Burlington Chine. He was informed that Purbeck District Council had authorised the removal of the bin for a trial period, in an attempt to curb the illegal fly-tipping that often occurred in the vicinity.

MR. C. BRIGHT thanked Councillor Suttle for conducting the Public Participation sessions during his term of Office, and also the Town Clerk for providing answers to the many queries raised.

MRS. SAUNDERS referred to the seats that had recently been removed from the Bandstand, Sandpit Field and Beach Gardens and enquired whether they would be re-instated. She was informed by the Council's Operations Manager that these seats had been taken in for repair and re-furbishment, as part of the general maintenance programme. It was intended that the majority of these seats would be replaced.
