Henoted the Town Council's observation to refuse the application and the concernex pressed at the quality of the design and the material stobe used, but felt that the Council's concernative loss of an other hotel should be recorded.$ 

 $\underline{COUNCILLORMRS.WHEELDON,} Chairof the PlanningBoard at PurbeckDistrictCouncil, explained that, whils to concern could be expressed at "the loss of an other hotel", there was no legislation to prevent it.$ 

 $\underline{COUNCILLORTRITE}\ also explained that if such an application was refused on "change of use" grounds, the decision would probably be overturned on Appeal to the Planning Inspectorate on the basis of "supply and demand of the market". Appeals of this nature usually proved costly, and resulted in an added burden on the local council tax payer.$ 

<u>MR.STOLLERY</u> acknowledgedtheinformationgiven, and then enquired whether, under the auspices of the Local Plan, tighter control could be exercised regarding the type of material sused for replacement buildings.

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
