**Briefing Note - Update**

**Proposed introduction of Pay and Display parking on Shore Road (restricted to cars and motorcycles only) and Station Road**

Since the issuing of the briefing note that went to the August Monthly Meeting, further responses have been received bringing the total to 82. These are analysed below.

<b>Pay and Display parking along Shore Road</b>	49 (60%)	16 (20%)	17 (20%)
<b>Pay and Display parking along Station Road</b>	41 (50%)	26 (32%)	15 (18%)
<b>Cars and motorcycles only along Shore Road</b>	56 (68%)	9 (11%)	17 (21%)

The following comments were also made during the consultation exercise, the number of times being given in ( ).

- Concern re camper van parking moving into other roads in Swanage (6)
- Need for better enforcement (4)
- Traffic flow in Station Road needs improvement/ increased parking will make worse (4)
- New regulations are unnecessary if current regulations were better enforced (3)
- Don't agree that blue badge holders should park for free (3)
- Hope that blue badge holders will still be able to park for free (3)
- Charging in Shore Road should be restricted to summer months (3)
- Shore Road should have no parking (3) / be pedestrianised (1)
- Close Shore Road from Easter (2)
- Shore Road is dangerous for two-way traffic (2)
- Parking charges on Shore Road should be higher than in car parks (2)
- Parking machines are unsightly (2)
- Works vans should not be banned from Shore Road (2)
- Parking on one side of Station Road only
- Unloading bays should be provided in Station Road (2)
- On-street parking should be free until 10 a.m. as in car parks (2)
- Something should be done about shoppers who park in loading bay in Institute Road
- Car parks are too expensive and under used
- Station Road – no charges but restrict waiting to ½ hour/ seasonal pay and display only/ first 20 minutes should be free
- Motorcycles should be exempt from charges.

Shore Road should be parking for Disabled Badge holders only

There is too much parking in Institute Road – lorries have to mount the pavement

There should be designated overnight parking for campervans

Concern re parking in lower High Street especially during the evening

Concern re motorcycles parking on pavement outside Gee Whites

Designated parking spaces for campervans on Shore Road away from the beach huts

Restrictions on camper vans during the summer months only

What provisions will be made for delivery drivers
