



## Welcome to Peveril Point Boat Park

*For the 2017 season the Boat Park will be available for daily slipway launches only with a small number of trailer spaces available. There is no facility for the storage of boats as the area is currently being underpinned to ensure that it can open at a later date.*

### Charges

All launches will incur the daily rate:

- Boat only – £21.00 (residents permit holders £15.75)
- Trailer storage £7.00 (residents permit holders £5.25)

A number of trailer spaces are available in the Boat Park. However four additional spaces are available, subject to availability, at the North Beach car park. Trailer storage permits can only be procured from the Boat Park Attendant.

### Ways to Pay

Payment can be made in the following ways:

- Pay the attendant – by card or cash (card payment available from end June)
- Pay in person at the Swanage Information Centre (card or cash)
- Pay on the phone on 01929 422855 or email [mail@swanage.gov.uk](mailto:mail@swanage.gov.uk) if you wish to book in advance
- Pay online [www.swanage.gov.uk/Boat\\_Park.aspx](http://www.swanage.gov.uk/Boat_Park.aspx) (available from end June)

We encourage users to book tickets for the slipway in advance, although we are unable to offer advance tickets for trailers.

Payment is required at all times – the Boat Park is covered by CCTV and regular patrols by Enforcement Officers.

## **Before approaching the slipway please note the following**

- A number of changes have taken place in the Boat Park
- Be aware of pedestrians passing along and across the slipway – this is a public right of way, and around the boat park in general
- Keep speed to a minimum at all times
- Be aware of the one way traffic system in place
- Do not unhitch trailer except in the designated places (on the lower part of slipway)
- Ensure you have checked the condition of your break away cable and trailer in general
- Please ensure you check the tide times before entering the water
- 5 knot speed limit across the bay
