



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VICTORIA AVENUE, SWANAGE

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along VICTORIA AVENUE, SWANAGE between its junctions with DeMoulham Road and Shore Road, a distance of approximately 75 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on Monday 25 January 2016 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Sunday 14 February 2016.

This order will enable the Environment Agency safe access to replace their existing covers lids and surrounds within the highway.

An alternative vehicular route will be signed using Shore Road, Ulwell Road, Seaward Road and DeMoulham Road and the reverse route.
