

Minutes of the Meeting of the **CARPARKING
BEST VALUE WORKING GROUP** held at the

1. **APOLOGIES**

An apology for his inability to attend the Meeting was received from Councillor Suttle.

2. **PARKING PROPOSALS AT PEVERIL POINT**

1. **Residents**

The Clerk provided Members with details of outstanding issues relating to the proposals at Peveril Point. Information was given regarding land ownership issues as identified by the Council’s solicitors. No details were provided regarding the rights of way issues related to individual properties.

The Clerk detailed the matters related to the classification of Broad Road and Peveril Point Road as a ‘bridleway’. The Chairman re-affirmed the Council’s intention not to restrict access over the roadway and the potential use of designated areas for parking.

Following a general discussion regarding the need to progress matters, it was decided to set out a course of action.

It was UNANIMOUSLY AGREED:-

To arrange a meeting with residents seeking either:-

a) an assurance that the parking proposals are introduced without legal challenge or;

b) the withdrawal of all parking restrictions on Peveril Point Road public access, allowing full public access.

It was FURTHER AGREED:-

To seek responses to the proposal to allocate forty-five permits at a fee of £125 (Incl VAT) and to restrict any rises in the fees in the next five years to a set increase plus inflation.

2. **RNLI**

The Clerk reported on a recent site meeting with representatives of the RNLI and the Council’s Best Value Working Group. The issues relating to car parking matters were outlined.

- a) Use of Garage/Store
The Clerk confirmed that the RNLIs were interested in pursuing arrangements for possible demolition and use of the garage/store. In discussing this matter it was AGREED:-

That any proposals and arrangements for the RNLIs' use of the garage store site be deferred until the conclusion of the parking proposals with residents.

- b) Parking along Peveril Point Road
Proposals for the removal of stones and the provision of emergency parking in the vicinity of the embankment, opposite coastguard cottages, be considered.

After a brief discussion regarding the enforcement requirements it was AGREED:-

To provide a designated emergency parking area, subject to the implementation of the proposed parking order.

3. **TAXI OPERATIONS**

The Town Clerk reported problems that were being experienced in the operation of the Taxi ranks.

After a general discussion it was AGREED:-

That the Town Clerk be authorised to instigate the appropriate enforcement measures.

4. **DATE OF NEXT MEETING**

It was agreed that a Meeting be held with residents of Peveril Point to be held at the Town Hall on 12th July 2002 at 7.00pm.
