

**NOTES** on the **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**  
**TIME** held on **MONDAY, 1<sup>st</sup> SEPTEMBER**  
**2003** in the Town Hall, Swanage at 7 o'clock p.m.

He agreed that the positioning of the containers would be referred to the next meeting of the Car Parks Best Value Working Group.
