

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WILLS ROAD, SWANAGE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along WILLS ROAD, SWANAGE between Steer Road and Priest's Road (in both directions) a distance of 65 metres. The Order is needed to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on Monday 8th February 2021 and will remain in force for 18 months. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by Friday 5th March 2021.

**This Order will enable JDT Utilities, agents for SGN, safe access to undertake major gas mains replacement works.**

Alternative routes will be sign posted, as indicated by the blue line on the map below.
