5) <u>Update from the Beach Management Advisory Committee Meeting held on 11th November 2020</u>

As chairman, Councillor Bonfield provided an overview of the meeting of the Beach Management Advisory Committee held on 11th November 2020, at which he had been reelected. It was reported that a presentation had been provided by Bridget Betts, Environmental Advice Manager for Dorset Council regarding water safety in Swanage and Studland bays. The success of multi-agency working had been noted, and it had been reported that improved systems for reporting inappropriate behaviour on the water had been established.

Problems arising from the launching of motorised craft in Swanage bay were discussed, including vehicles using the parish slipway to launch craft. The Advisory Committee had recommended the restriction of vehicular access at this location for safety reasons.

Further to discussion, it was proposed by the Chairman, seconded by Councillor Finch, and RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY:-

That consideration be given to the installation of bollards at the top of the parish slipway to prevent vehicular access on safety grounds, and that legal advice be sought accordingly.
