WHO WILL YOU NOMINATE?

Who do **YOU** think deserves to be recognised for their good works locally over the past year? **NOW** is your chance to nominate an award for a deserving individual or group.

INDIVIDUAL/GROUP AWARDS

Swanage Town Council wishes to give public recognition by way of an award to individuals or groups who have contributed significantly to the quality of life of the community by their public/community activity.

SPECIAL AWARD

A 'Special Award' may also be awarded by the awards panel to an individual or group for an outstanding achievement, or service provided to the community, during the year.

NOMINATIONS

Any member of the public who is a **registered elector in Swanage** may submit one or more nominations to Swanage Town Council. **Nominations will be open from Tuesday 11th February 2025 and must be received by no later than 12 noon on Thursday 6th March 2025.**

Town Councillors are eligible as long as the work being acknowledged has no connection to their Council responsibilities. Self-nominations or nominations by close relatives are acceptable.

Nominations can be made by email to admin@swanage.gov.uk, handed in at the Town Hall, or by post. A copy of the nomination form can be found on the [Town Council's website](#) and [Facebook page](#), or collected in person at the [Town Hall](#), or [Swanage Information Centre](#). Up to nine awards may be presented. An awards panel consisting of the Town Mayor, Deputy Mayor, an officer of the Town Council, Rector of Swanage, and President of Swanage & Purbeck Rotary Club, will select the winners.

Award Categories



**‘Shining a light on those people who go above and beyond to help others,
and who make Swanage a great place to live.’**

Community Award

To be presented to a group or organisation which has made an outstanding contribution to the town of Swanage and its residents

Volunteer of the Year

To be presented to an individual for their outstanding contribution to the town and its residents, and to celebrate the positive impact they have had on the local community

Service with a Smile

To be presented to an individual or group for their passion and commitment to exceptional service to others

Arts and Heritage

To be presented to an individual or group for their contribution to the local arts, science and cultural experience in the town

Green Champion

To be presented to an individual or group to recognise their efforts and achievements in relation to positive changes to the local environment, making Swanage a greener place to live in and enjoy (e.g. new green community initiatives, planting or caring for a vital habitat, encouraging/ supporting the uptake of active travel, or changing behaviours in support of the climate change agenda)

Youth Citizen of the Year

To be presented to a person under the age of 25 for compassionate works, volunteering or citizenship roles undertaken within the community, or at school

Small Business of the Year

To be presented to a local, independent business, which has positively contributed to the quality-of-life experience in the town

Lifetime Achievement

To be presented to an individual in recognition of their long-term commitment to volunteering, making a positive contribution to the town and its residents, and to celebrate the effort and dedication they have shown over a number of years
