

Swanage seasonal wave barriers

I am writing to confirm the Environment Agency's current position regarding the deployment of seasonal concrete wave barriers at Swanage.

I understand that since the winter of 2018, the Environment Agency, with assistance from Swanage Town Council, have deployed concrete wave barriers at three vulnerable locations around Swanage town centre. These have remained in place during the winter months in an effort to increase the flood protection to the local area from wave overtopping events.

Following a series of undesirable flooding events between 2016 and 2018, I understand that a number of temporary wave barrier options were trialled and tested by the Environment Agency and Swanage Town Council to reduce the reoccurrence of flooding from over the quayside. These trials identified the optimum location for the placement of temporary barriers and since the winter of 2018, the use of the seasonal concrete barriers, has been widely regarded as a successful temporary measure to improve the flood resilience of the community.

I note that Dorset Council, in collaboration with the Environment Agency and Swanage Town Council, are currently writing an outline business case for a permanent solution to the coastal flood risk and that the project is at an initial stage of public engagement. I would encourage all parties to work closely together to deliver a solution which both addresses the future flood risk and aligns with the aspirations of the community to enhance the sea front for public realm opportunities.

Given the intentions and timescales to deliver a permanent solution, I would propose that the concrete barriers are deployed for a further 2 winter seasons or as required to complement the permanent solution. We would expect to continue to work in partnership with Dorset Council and Swanage Town Council to obtain any necessary consents and maintain an active level of communication with the public.

We have worked with the Dorset Local Resilience Forum to develop and refine the protocol for barrier deployment and storm impacts, emphasising the need for working with partners such as HM Coastguard to provide a response to public safety. We would hope that all partners can remain committed to the protocol developed and that whilst the permanent solution is progressed, local businesses can actively support the wider message to the community.

I trust that this proposal is acceptable to the Town Council and that you can remain supportive of any deployment operations. We will continue to liaise closely over the coming months regarding the next planned deployment of concrete barriers and encourage the continued support to promote a permanent scheme.
