It was agreed that this would be an item on a forthcoming agenda for a full Council meeting.

70. <u>CAR PARK AND DE MOULHAM ESTATE SERVICE ROAD RESURFACING -</u> <u>AWARD OF CONTRACT</u>

Consideration was given to a briefing note prepared by the Operations Manager setting out the tender process undertaken for the resurfacing of Main Beach and North Beach car parks and De Moulham estate back roads, together with electrical installation works. Having been advertised on the Contracts Finder website five submissions had been received and assessed against both quality and financial criteria. The briefing note identified the highest scoring tender following analysis by Dorset Property.

It was proposed by Councillor Trite, seconded by Councillor Moreton and RESOLVED UNANIMOUSLY:

That the contract for the resurfacing of car parks and De Moulham estate back roads, together with electrical installation works at Main Beach car park, be awarded to NMC Contracting in the sum of $\pounds 143,996.46$.
